SUBJECT: Blue Card Information and ID Cards 2020

The blue card system has been reviewed and a No Card, No Start process is now in effect. No Card, No Start will mean that all coaches and volunteers must have a blue card (not just a pending application) before they can work with children (this includes training and game days).

You should allow at least 28 business days for our application to be processed. It will take longer for the form to be processed if the form is not filled in correctly.

All clubs should check with all volunteers and coaches that their blue card is current. If you need to renew or apply for a blue card you will not be able to work with children until you receive the blue card.

Mini Roos – Friday 6th March

Juniors (not U12's) - Friday 6th March
