SUBJECT: Senior Grand Finals

Dear Colleagues,

Football Gold Coast would like to provide our senior clubs some more information regarding the Senior Grand Finals. FGC has decided to separate the Senior Grand Final Day into two separate days for Premier League and Coast League. The finals will be hosted by the premiership winner of each respective competition, subject to the condition that the club meets the set criteria.

The finals are scheduled for;

- Senior Men's Premier League- Saturday 14th of November
 - o PL Reserves- 2:30pm
 - o PL- 5:30pm
- Senior Men's Coast League- Sunday 15th of November
 - o CL Reserves- 1:45pm
 - o CL- 4:30pm

The host of the Premier League Grand Final will also host the Westpac Shooting Stars Challenge Final in between the two fixtures.

The criteria to host a Senior Grand Final is as follows;

- Supply sufficient spectator facilities (canteen, seating, shade, toilet facilities etc.)
- Sufficient car parking
- Available warm up areas for competing teams
- PA System
- Minimum of two (2) changing rooms for home and away teams
- Match officials room
- First aid provider visually present and at the disposal of all patrons and visitors.
- Fields to be inspected by FGC 2 weeks prior to determining suitability
- Fencing around the playing field (may be temporary)
- Supplying designated ground officials/security on the day
- FGC delegate tent (if required)
- Conform with all COVID-19 guidelines

Should the winner of the premiership not meet the set criteria to host then the hosting rights will be offered to the premiership runner up. If they do not meet the criteria then FGC will determine the host.
