SUBJECT: Westpac Shooting Stars Challenge

Dear Colleagues,

Our Westpac Shooting Stars Challenge is underway and will continue to run at our Premier League and Coast League clubs for the next month or so. Clubs have been and will continue to be contacted to inform them on their session times on their respective training nights.

The Westpac Shooting Stars Challenge rules are as follows;

- FGC will visit each club at an agreed time to carry out the preliminary rounds
- Each team will get 16 shots + 1 coach shot
- Points will be accumulated if teams successfully hit the designated targets
- The total points will be accumulated and put into a table with all the other PL and CL teams
- The three highest scoring teams will be invited to the Premier League Grand Final Day to participate in the final which will be held in between the PL Reserves and PL finals.
- If at the conclusion of the preliminary rounds there are multiple teams on the same points, the following tiebreaker will be applied to determine the final standings
 - o Team with the most amount of "200" scores and if tied
 - o Team with the most amount of "150" scores and if tied
 - o Team with the most amount of "100" scores and if tied
 - o If the teams are still tied than a playoff will occur to determine the final 3 positions
- For the final, teams will be represented by 5 players who must be In team uniform will have 3 shots each
- The total prize pool for the competition will be \$2,000 split into the following
 - o 1st- \$1,250
 - o 2nd- \$500
 - o 3rd- \$250
- The highest point scorer of the preliminary rounds will choose when they will shoot followed by the second highest point scorer determining their position
- If scores are level in the finals once all shots are complete, the five players will have one shot each to determine the overall play-off score.
