SUBJECT: Alcohol at Venues

Dear Colleagues,

It has been brought to our attention by Gold Coast City Council that spectators at venues are bringing their own alcohol to licensed venues and drinking outside the nominated areas of the premises.

As per the Liquor Licensing Act 1992, patrons are only permitted to consume alcohol at the designated areas within a licensed venue and are not permitted to bring their own alcohol at any point.

If clubs find that patrons are consuming alcohol that is not purchased at their venue or consuming alcohol in areas that are not licensed, they are able to contact local police as this is considered as breaking the law and the patron may be charged.

We ask all patrons and spectators to please support their local clubs by purchasing drinks at the venue and only consuming alcohol in licensed areas at the club.
