Dear Colleagues,

Following today's announcement by the Queensland Government of the lifting of lockdown restrictions across parts of Queensland from 6pm tonight, Friday 2 July and in consultation with Football Queensland, Football Gold Coast would like to provide the following update for all participants and clubs.

Due to the 24-hour extension of the lockdown in the Brisbane area and the impact that will have on teams with the unavailability of players and officials residing in that region, coupled with the impending inclement weather we have decided that in the best interest and safety of all concerned we are postpone all games scheduled for this weekend.

As a result **ALL** Premier League and Coast League games will be rescheduled as listed below :-

### Premier League

Round 13 rescheduled to the weekend of 23/24/25 July.

- All games will be played on the same day; time and venue that they were originally scheduled.
  - *i.e if your game was scheduled to be played on Friday 2<sup>nd</sup> July at 7.00pm it will now be played on Friday 23<sup>rd</sup> July at 7.00pm*

### Coast League

- Round 16 will be rescheduled to :-
  - Reserve Grade – Tuesday 13<sup>th</sup> July at 7.00pm
  - First Grade – Tuesday 20<sup>th</sup> July at 7.00pm

All fixtures will be update on SportsTG by COB today.

As per the instructions of Football QLD and the State Government all other football related activities (training etc) on the Gold Coast may resume after 6.00pm tonight.

As football recommences across the Gold Coast, clubs and participants are reminded of the requirement to follow the Queensland Government restrictions currently in place, including carrying a mask at all times.
